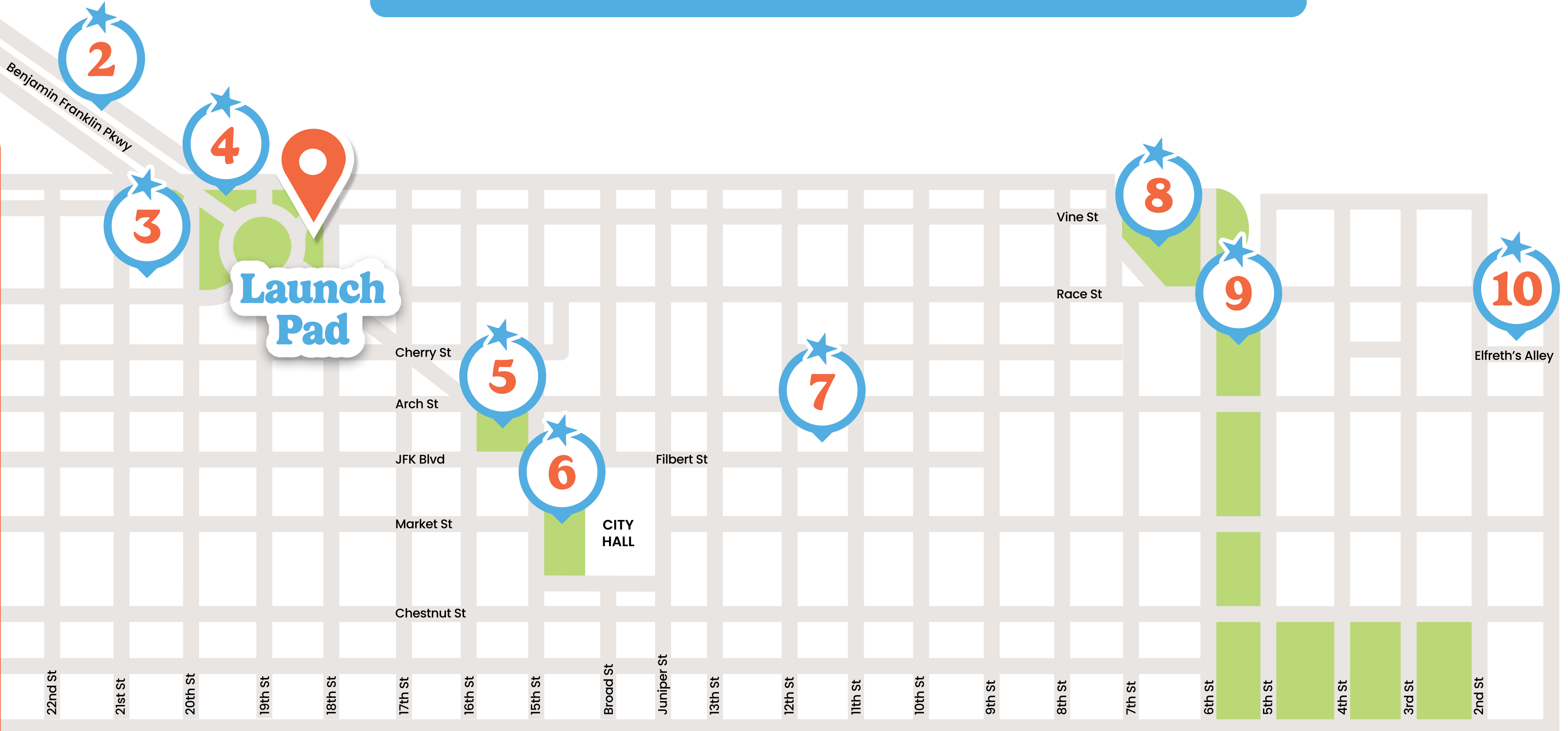


The Play Place
